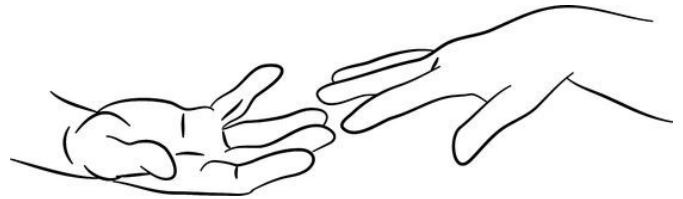
## Why be a mentor?
